How to make a dog toy

Here is a toy you can make for a dog.

You will need

- 4 small old socks
- 1 medium old sock
- 1 large old sock



- Step 1** Roll a small sock into a ball.
- Step 2** Repeat step 1 until you have four sock-balls.
- Step 3** Put the sock-balls inside a medium-sized sock. Tie a knot in the end.
- Step 4** Put the medium-sized sock (knot side first) into a large sock. Tie a knot in the end.



Note: Your final sock should not have any holes in it.
